



Reciprocal Club Agreement



Royal Perth Golf Club Inc (RPGC)
of Labouchere Road, South Perth, Western Australia

and

Goldfields Golf Club (GGC)
of 93 Aslett Drive, Karlkurla, Western Australia

enter in to this Reciprocal Club Agreement whereby:

1. Each of the undersigned Clubs shall extend to any visiting Member of the other Club all the privileges to the Golf Course and other Club facilities given to its own Members in the category of membership which is closest to the rights and privileges to which the visiting Member is entitled at their own club. Absentee and Overseas members are not permitted to use Reciprocal Rights.
2. The above mentioned privileges will be exclusive of the regular fee usually charged to visitors and for a maximum of six (6) days in any calendar year. Any additional rounds above this limit will be charged the standard Member Guest rate at RPGC and Standard Visitor Rate at GGC.
3. Reciprocal Members must produce an introductory card or letter upon arrival, which is to include category of membership as well as current handicap and/or Golf Link number. It is also preferable that a letter be forwarded by the Reciprocal Member's Club in advance advising of the impending visit.
4. Reciprocal Members shall be subject to all Rules, By-laws and other controls in effect at the time of their visit.
5. All purchases for meals, drinks, etc must be paid for in cash or by credit/debit card.
6. Each Reciprocal Member shall have the same rights to introduce guests as a member of the host Club (subject to course availability) and such visitor shall pay the normal green fee applicable to a guest playing with a Member. At Royal Perth Golf Club, a Reciprocal Member is entitled to introduce up to three (3) guests at any one time for social play. In Members' competition events, a maximum of two visitors will apply for each four ball. A guest must be a current member of an affiliated State Association Golf Club and can only be introduced to the Club up to a maximum of six (6) times per calendar year. Guests cannot be introduced on Wednesday afternoons and Saturdays.
7. Reciprocal Members and guests will be allowed access to the club competitions at the discretion of the Club Captain. Their eligibility to win trophies will also be at the Captain's discretion and they shall be informed prior to tee-off.
8. A Member of GGC residing temporarily for more than one continuous month or on a permanent basis within 100km of the Perth CBD is not entitled to Reciprocal privileges at RPGC beyond the first month of residency. Similarly a member of RPGC residing temporarily for more than one continuous month or on a permanent basis in the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder is not entitled to Reciprocal privileges at GGC beyond one month of residency.
9. This Agreement shall remain in force until such time as either Club, or the "City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder" (being the owner of the Kalgoorlie Golf Course), upon written notice terminates it giving three months' notice.
